Whole tree mutation of a red Fuji found in Washington, USA.

The Fruit

Size	Medium to large. Count 70-100
Colour	70-80% red blush skin with yellow green
	background colour. Creamy white flesh.
Russet	Typical to Fuji

	Typical Fuji flavour. Very juicy and sweet
	with low acid.
Harvest	4-6 weeks earlier than standard Fuji.
Storage	Keeping qualities similar to Gala. Up to 4
	months in standard air storage at 0°C and

Moderately vigorous, with very good productivity.

Comments

September Wonder[®] Fuji is the earliest true Fuji on the market. Early Fujis made up 7% of the apple plantings in the USA between 2001 and 2007, with September Wonder[®] Fuji being the number one choice. Early Fuji strains make up an estimated 10% of the USA's entire Fuji crop.

Early Fuji are not considered a Fuji replacement, but a complementary product, to take advantage of early market premiums. Early Fuji is a good balancing tool for the grower and packer.
